Mayor Robert Yerick called the Public Hearing to order at 7:00pm. The purpose of the Public Hearing was to receive comment on Local Law #6/2008 and Local Law #7/2008.

Mayor Yerick explained that Local Law #6/2008 was a law amending the parking meter law, changing the fee structure and the time of meter enforcement. Trustee Campbell advised the Board that he presented the proposed law to SAMA. SAMA recommended that the time of meter enforcement begin at 9:00am and not approve to change to 10:00am. There was no one from the public who wished to comment on the law.

Mayor Yerick explained Local Law #7/2008 – this law prohibits any Village Department Superintendent hired after October 31, 2008 from using a Village owned vehicle for transportation to and from their place of residence. This change exempts the Police and Fire Chiefs. There was no one from the Public who wished to comment on the law.

Motion was made by Trustee Karashay, seconded by Trustee Moore, to close the Public Hearing. Carried. The Public Hearing was closed at 6:55pm.
