Mayor Yerick opened the Public Hearing at 6:30pm. The Public Hearing was to receive comment on proposed Local Law #3/2007 – changes to the Zoning Law. The changes include modifications in the B2 District – changing P (permitted) to S (Special Use Permit required) for used auto sales, gas stations, fast food restaurants, and enclosed storage. Also in the Planned Waterfront District – add S under Hotel or motel. And allowing uses under S in the Industrial District for row/town houses; recreation club; commercial recreation facility; schools – professional, business and day care; auto sales – new and used; retail store; gas station; and greenhouse.

There was no one from the Public present.

The Board discussed the merits of the zoning law changes.

Motion was made by Mayor Yerick, seconded by Trustee Moore, to close the Public Hearing. Carried. The Public Hearing was closed at 6:45pm.
