The CRZ projects funding from GOSR expires in 2022 on all projects. We should have the two remaining CRZ projects, Water Prefilter and Water Supplemental Source Exploration, done before the deadline.

**Trustee Buono** questioned whether or not the aerators had been installed at the beach. **Trustee Parisian** stated that the electriacian has been contacted and is working on getting it done. Anchoring them is a question. DPW will be dong the installation.

#### Deputy Mayor Mayer reported

- The Chamber of Commerce mixer speaker was Anna Leonard, Marketing Director for HITS.
- Arts Commission Board is working on their website design, logo variations progress and memebership.
- TV23 will be updating the bulletin board on a regular basis and running old shows.

• The meeting of the Chamber, Saugerties Tourism and Destination Saugerties discussed working together under the same title, linking the websites, and boosting a their videos. A sidewalk sale, holiday market and a scanvanger hunt are all events in the planning stages.

• The developer for Autozone, John Joseph, will be replacing the service organizations and church signs at the entrance of the Village near the Autozone project. The new format is being designed by Mark Smith and being reviewed for pricing. DOT will be involved with the siting of the signs.

**Lisa Mayone** stated that Shout Out Saugerties asked if they would be allowed to have an ice cream truck, Frozen Caboose, at the Village Beach for the unveiling of the mural on Friday, August 7th. Shout Out Saugerties had originally asked Alleway Ice Cream and Mickey's Igloo if they were interested in doing it but neither could do it. The ice cream truck would be there for the unveiling only, approximately from 5 -7pm, as a one time event.
