July 19, 2010

Mayor Murphy called the Public Hearing to order at 6:50pm. The purpose of the Public Hearing was to received input regarding Local Law #2/2010 that revises the signage standards in the historic district section of Village Zoning Code.

Alex Wade explained the revision by saying the law deals with neon and LED signs in the Historic District. Instead of banning all neon signs, this law places more reasonable restrictions on businesses in the district. In addition, all the signage laws will be printed in one area of the Village Code.

Trustee LeBlanc asked if the DPW is allowed by law to remove illegal signage within the Village. She mentioned signs placed in residential areas advertising businesses. Mayor Murphy suggested that this Public Hearing was to discuss the new signage standards in the Historic District and perhaps this question should be discussed in another forum.

Trustee Landewe spoke saying this law was to bring more businesses into compliance and changes the “no neon” to a more reasonable law. Mayor Murphy added this law assists business owners.

Trustee Buono said it is a very appropriate modification to the law.

There was no one from the public who wished to comment on the law.

Mayor Murphy thanked the Historic Review Board, Trustee Landewe, Alex Wade and Eyal Saad for their work on the law.

Motion was made by Mayor Murphy, seconded by Trustee Buono, to close the Public Hearing. Carried. The Public Hearing closed at 7:00pm.
